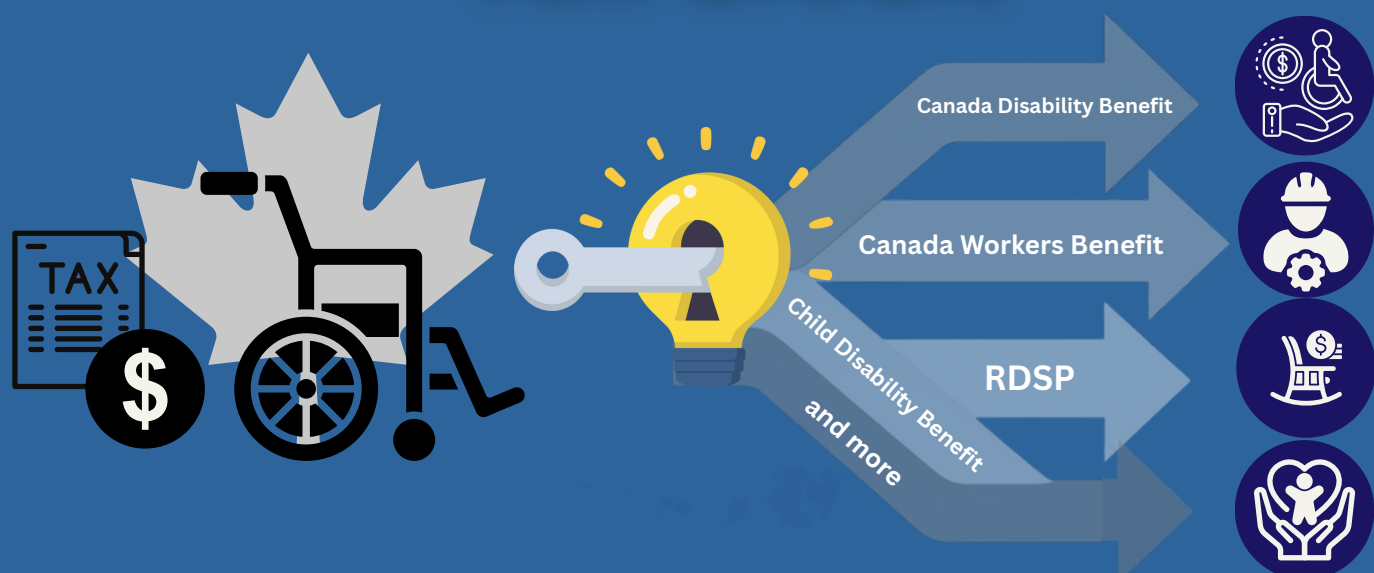


Fixing the Disability Tax Credit

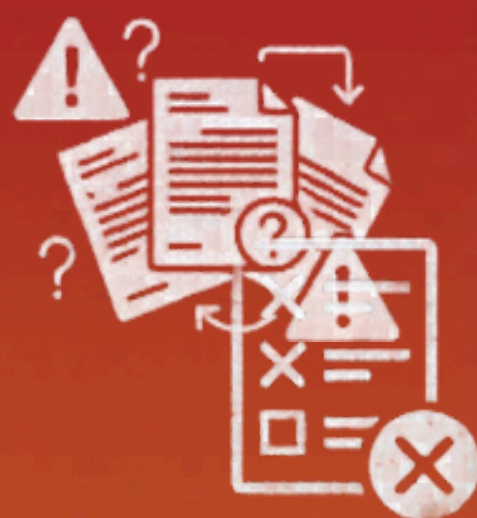


What is the Disability Tax Credit?

The Disability Tax Credit (DTC) is non-refundable tax credit for persons with disabilities to help with costs.

The **DTC is key** to getting other federal benefits and income like the Canada Disability Benefit and RDSP and more.

The Problem



- Too many applications
- Application is confusing
- Visits to healthcare professionals is hard
- No family doctor
- Doctors charge \$150 or more to fill out the form
- Not understanding the benefits of the DTC



The Fix



- Make the DTC automatic if you are already on disability social assistance (ex. AISH, MSPD, ODSP)
- Share Information between governments (with permission)
- Use the same definition of disability
- Let people fill out the form themselves and only needing a signature
- Pay for the costs of medical forms
- Limit the amount DTC promoters can charge
- Let community organizations help
